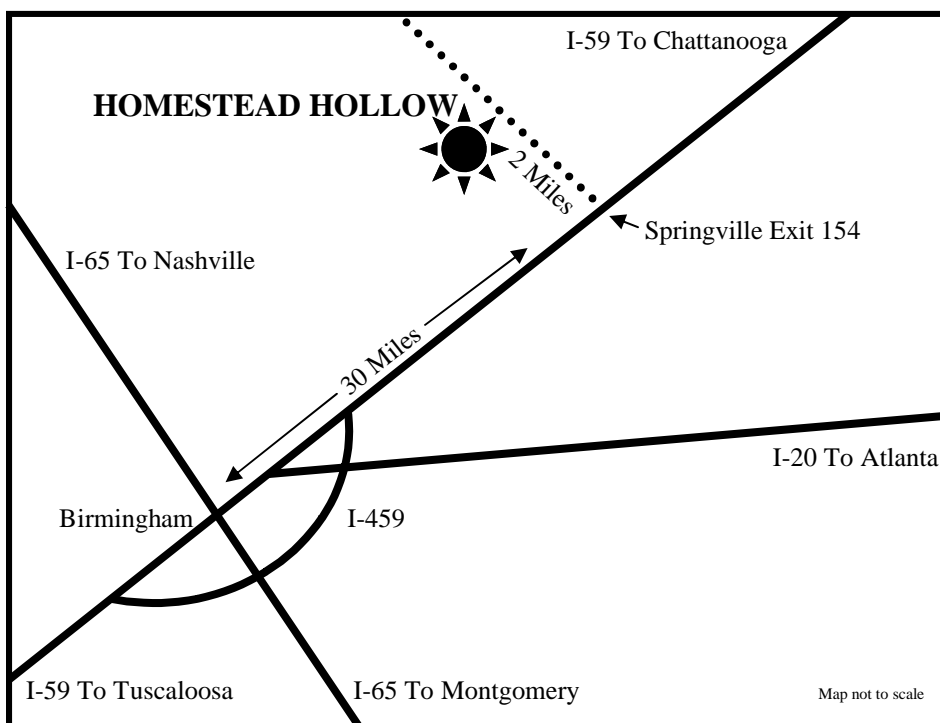

We are proud to present Homestead Hollow's 2010 festivals featuring fine arts, hand made and hand decorated crafts, pioneer demonstrators, live entertainment, food, and children's activities. These 3 day festivals are family oriented and advertised by TV, radio, flyers, newspapers, magazines, billboards, and the internet.

The Homestead Hollow festivals have been quite successful for the past 28 years. Approximately 150 vendors from fine arts, handmade crafts, hand decorated items, and demonstrators exhibit at each show.

Homestead Hollow is located in Springville, Alabama, just 2 miles off I-59, exit 154.



## APPLICATION PROCESS:

Homestead Hollow festivals are juried shows. The selection jury will approve exhibitor applications based on creativity, quality, originality, and booth display. Exhibitors are limited to 2 categories per booth. Exhibitors must furnish at least 4 photographs of finished work to be sold, 4 photographs of work in progress including at least 1 photo of artist/crafter at work, 4 photographs of raw materials, and 1 photograph of a booth set-up for a total of at least 13 photographs. **No slides, picture cds or photos by email will be accepted.** Photographs will not be returned and will be kept for our files. Good, quality photocopies of photographs will be accepted. All work exhibited must be comparable to work shown in photographs. *Only complete applications will be considered by the jury committee.* Complete applications include:

Application, filled out and signed.  
Required photographs.  
Booth fees.  
Jury fee.

Following acceptance, exhibitors will receive a final acceptance letter with set-up and lodging information. **Once accepted, no refunds will be given.** Check or money orders of exhibitors not accepted will be returned.

## WEATHER:

Homestead Hollow is a rain or shine event. The festival does not close during intermittent rain. In the event of prolonged, inclement weather, the festival may delay opening or be cancelled with no refunds given. It is the responsibility of the vendors to be present for notification of delays or cancellations.

## FESTIVAL RULES AND RESTRICTIONS:

All merchandise to be sold by festival participants must be hand-made or hand decorated by the festival participant.

No "sets" will be sold that include any items which are not hand-made or hand decorated by the festival participant.

Vendors shall be present during the entire festival to display and/or sell his or her arts/crafts.

Artist are allowed to sell copies of their own, original works of art. Example: Greeting cards or printed clothing made from the participants original works of art.

Festival participants are not allowed to advertise commercially available goods, products or services.

No storage containers are to be left in view. Booths must be neat and have a pleasing appearance.

Limited booths have extra space behind the booth. This space is available to rent for an additional fee. This area is not to be used for extra display area, only storage or personal use.

Booths are designated with wooden stakes. Stakes define the front and sides of booths. No booths, racks or other items are to exceed the boundaries of each booth.

Homestead Hollow officials reserve the right to reject any application for entry into the festival.

Homestead Hollow officials reserve the right to terminate the participation of any festival participant at any time. Festival participants terminated shall not receive any refund of their entry fee.

No vehicles or trailers of any type will be permitted in the exhibition area during show hours.

No alcoholic beverages and no drugs allowed.

No profane language, lewd or vulgar conduct will be tolerated.

Homestead Hollow officials reserve the right to require the removal of any work by festival vendors that the officials deems inappropriate for display or sale at any festival.

Homestead Hollow officials reserve the right to amend, alter, or change these rules in whole or in part with or without prior notice to any festival participant and to interpret and apply these rules as Homestead Hollow officials, in their absolute discretion, deems necessary and appropriate.

## PARKING/CAMPING/ SECURITY:

Parking passes will be furnished and must be displayed on dash of vehicle. Exhibitor vehicles must park in designated area. Limited RV hook-ups (electric & water) are available and assigned. Shower facilities are available on the premises. Security is provided Thursday through Saturday night. No pets are allowed in the vendor section. **NO GENERATORS ALLOWED.**

## SET-UP AND CHECK IN:

Only white tents or off-white tents are allowed, no green, blue or other colors. Vendors check in at office and pick up registration packets. Check in and set-up is on Thursday from 8:30 am until dark, or Friday from 6:00 am until 7:30 am. Vendors not checked in by Friday at 7:30 am will not be allowed to participate in the festival. Vendors may check in on Wednesday only with special permission. Exhibitors must be set up by 8:30 am Friday and remain in

place until the close of the show on Sunday. All exhibitors must furnish their own tent and display units. A card with the exhibitor's name and space number will be provided in registration packets and must be prominently displayed on booth throughout the festival. Name tags will be also be provided and must be worn by all exhibitors at all times.

**All vehicles must be removed from the exhibition area by 8:30 a.m. on festival days.**

## SALES TAX:

All vendors are responsible for collecting and paying, state, county and city sales tax. Tax forms are in registration packets to be picked up at vendor check in.

## CLEAN UP

Do not leave garbage on the ground, especially plastic ties. Vendors that leave their area in unacceptable conditions, will be banned from participation at future events.
